

Directions to LIFT

Transport

Train: DLR – East India

Tube: Canning Town / North Greenwich

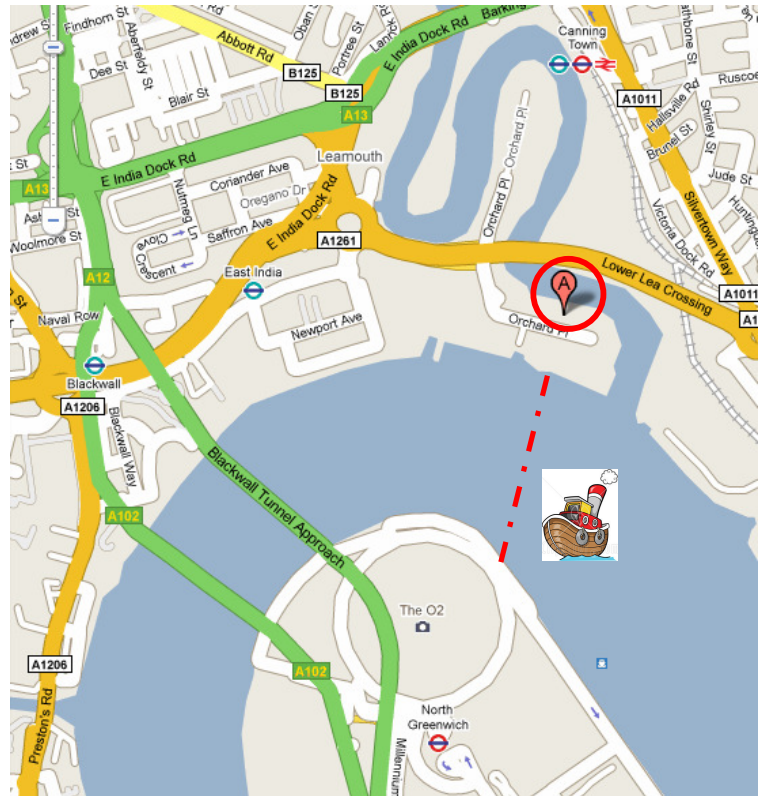
Air: London City Airport

River: Trinity Buoy Wharf Pier

Bus: Number 277, alighting at the Town Hall on the north side of East India (DLR) station.

DLR: To East India, followed by a 10 minute walk. Please do not walk over the footbridge at the station, instead use the stairs to the south exit. Outside of the station follow the blue signs marked either Trinity Buoy Wharf or the Bird Sanctuary.

Car: Follow signs to Leamouth on the A13 or from Aspen Way. At the Leamouth roundabout (Esso Petrol Station), take the Lower Lea Crossing exit. Almost immediately, go left after the bridge. At the T-junction turn right onto Orchard Place and follow the road round to Trinity Buoy Wharf. Parking is available on site.



Tube: Jubilee Line

Canning Town

From here it is a 15 minute walk. Exit from the north end (closest to the ticket office). Go to the large roundabout and turn left leading you over the River Lea bridge. Turn left at the foot of the bridge and follow the Lea to the roundabout with the Esso Station on the right. Keep following the Lea round to the left by PURA Foods and the path emerges onto Orchard Place. Bear right and continue on until you reach Trinity Buoy Wharf at the end.

North Greenwich

From here it is a 5 minute walk to the Queen Elizabeth II Pier from where Thames Clippers depart. There is also a small fishing boat (some days going by the boat 'Assassin', others 'Predator') which offers a free service to Trinity Buoy staff and visitors across the river. Boat departure times depend on demand so if it's not docked call the LIFT office (020 7093 6340) and we'll make sure the boat comes to collect you. It's a 3 minute pleasant journey across. When you arrive, cross the bridge from pier onto mainland, walk right along the river to the end and then follow the curve to your left and you will see LIFT's offices in the blue container on your left.

The LIFT offices are in a blue container, situated directly opposite a big red container - Fatboy's Diner.
